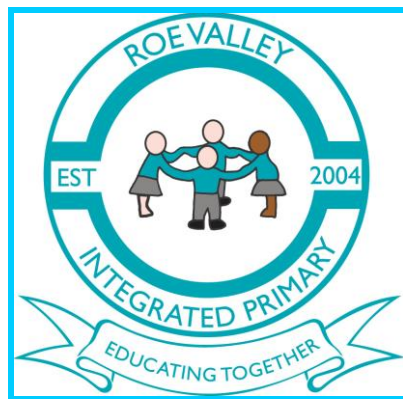


‘Parents and Friends of Roe Valley Integrated Primary School’
